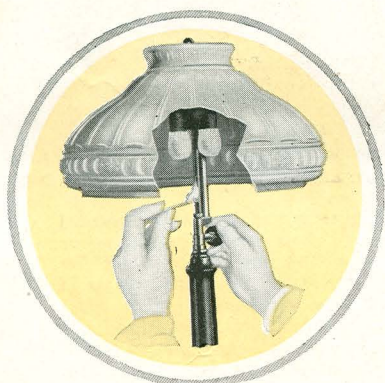

The Ready-Lite shade is made of highest quality, heat-resisting, lead glass. It has been designed especially for American Ready-Lites, to insure durability and proper diffusion of light. The Ready-Lite Lamp has universal shade holder, which fits all standard gasoline lamp shades.

American Lanterns, the original gasoline lanterns, are best for every purpose for which a lantern is used, being wind-rain- and insect-proof. They are ideal about the farm and farm buildings, in the garage and workshop, for lighting poultry houses, pavilions, camps, boats, docks, tent shows, lumbering and construction work, hunting—wherever an abundance of brilliant light is desired, there you will find American Ready-Lite Lanterns.

Ready-Lite Lanterns are built like, and operate on the same principle, as the lamp. Like the lamp, the lantern fount is heavy gauge brass finished in polished nickel. The lantern uses the same straight, long-life generator and has the same patented mixing chamber and burner casting.

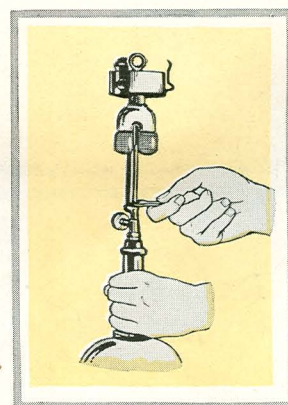
The porcelain enameled tops used on American Ready-Lite Lanterns mark a most decided improvement in gasoline lanterns and greatly increase the strength and durability of the Ready-Lite. These tops will not rust, corrode, tarnish or burn out. Lantern may be lighted repeatedly for demonstration purposes, without becoming shabby or "secondhand" in appearance.

American Ready-Lite Lanterns may be had with built-in air pump. Lanterns so equipped have hand operated filler plug, the two parts being made in one unit. The large, one-inch filler opening makes these lanterns especially convenient to fill.

Ready-Lite generators are easily removed for cleaning or replacement, without breaking mantles, thereby effecting a very material saving in mantle expense.



AMERICAN Blue-Top Mantles are reinforced by gathering the surplus material in such a manner that the mantle is strongest at the bottom, where the strain is obviously greatest. That is why American Mantles last longer. They are made by hand, in our own factory, and will not split open or pull out at the seam like the ordinary machine-made mantles.

Genuine American Blue-Top Mantles are identified by the name "AMERICAN" on the carton and on the glassine envelope in which they are enclosed. Packed in cartons of one dozen; twelve cartons in attractive counter display box.

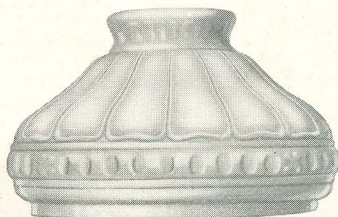


Ready-Lite generators are sealed in individual envelopes, and packed three dozen in an attractive counter display box.



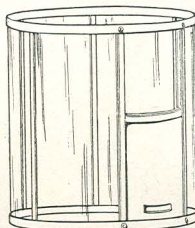
Ready-Lite Shades

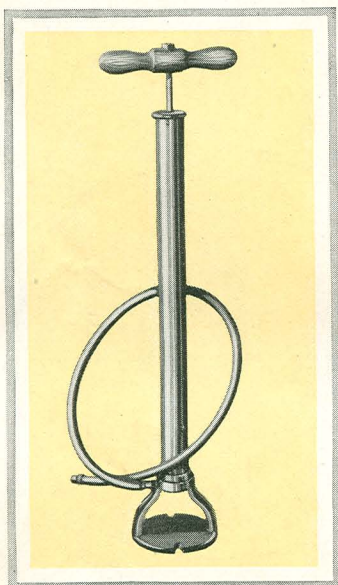
Ready-Lite Mica Globes

The mica globes or chimneys used on American Ready-Lite Lanterns are rustproof, the binding strips being made of brass instead of tin, which is usually used. They are made of clear select mica and fitted with brass lighting-door.



Insect Screen

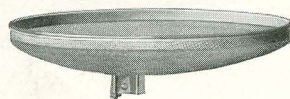
