

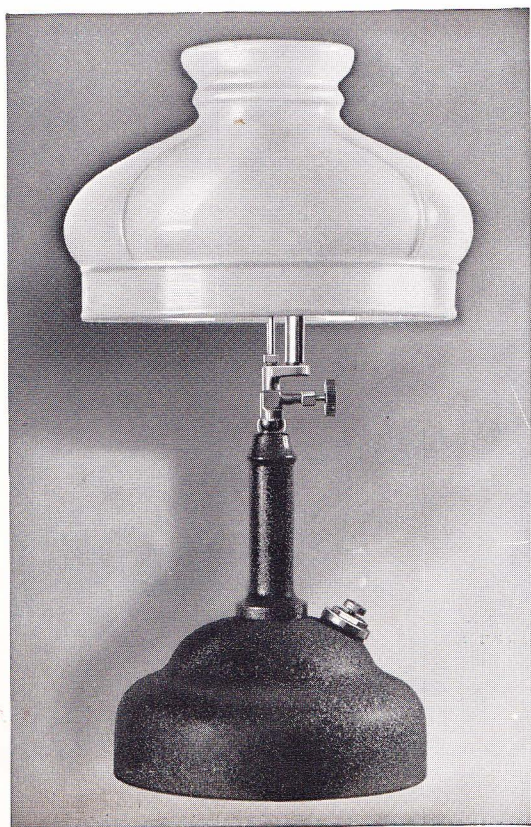
## AMERICAN READY-LITE LAMPS

AMERICAN Ready-Lite lamps give a brilliant, yet soft, white light that thoroughly dispels the darkness and makes it not only safe, but actually a pleasure to read and sew. At a cost of only  $\frac{1}{4}$  cent per hour, they give 300 candle power light.

### No. 3662 Ready-Lite Lamp

The utmost in mechanical perfection, convenience and beauty have been embodied in this lamp. The base or fount, finished in black crystalline enamel, the black fluted stem, the chromium trimmings and the artistic parchment shade—all combine to make this lamp outstanding in appearance.

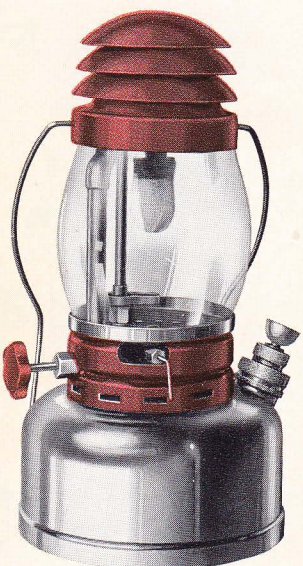
No. 3662 Ready-Lite Lamp has two mantles. Lights instantly without first generating. Just open the valve and apply a match. The light does not pulsate, and is therefore unsurpassed for reading or sewing. Has built-in pump, bakelite knob, and mica chimney to protect the shade from the heat. Holds 2 pints, sufficient for 12 to 15 hours burning. Height, 20 inches. Shipping weight, 9 pounds.



### No. 595 Ready-Lite Lamp

A match generating, two-mantle gasoline pressure lamp. The heat of two matches applied to the generator tube is sufficient to get the lamp lighted. Gives a brilliant, soft, white light which is properly diffused by an opal glass shade. Filler opening is one inch in diameter, making it easy to fill or clean out base. Base and handle are finished in dark green crystalline enamel. Fount holds 3 pints, sufficient for 15 to 18 hours burning. Height,  $19\frac{1}{2}$  inches. Shipping weight, 9 pounds.

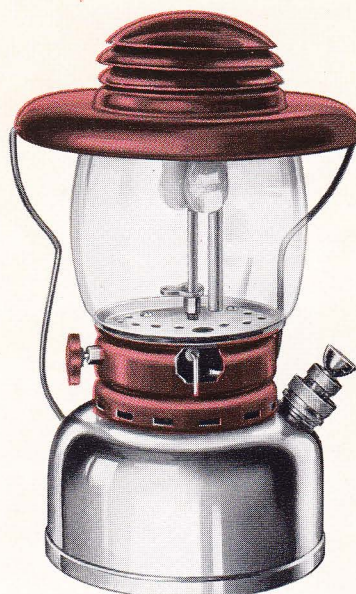
## AMERICAN READY-LITE LANTERNS

### No. 3708 Ready-Lite Lantern

This handy, compact, one mantle lantern will give lots of light, whether gasoline or kerosene is used as fuel. When burning gasoline, it is instant lighting—no generating. Just open the valve and light the mantle. When burning kerosene, an alcohol cup is located at the base of the generator. The globe is made of heat-resisting glass, the hood is maroon porcelain, and the base is chromium plated. Has combination built-in pump and filler plug. Clean-out lever is conveniently located on the collar of the lantern. Fount holds  $1\frac{1}{2}$  pints of gasoline, sufficient for 9 to 11 hours of operation. Height,  $11\frac{1}{2}$  inches; shipping weight, 5 pounds.



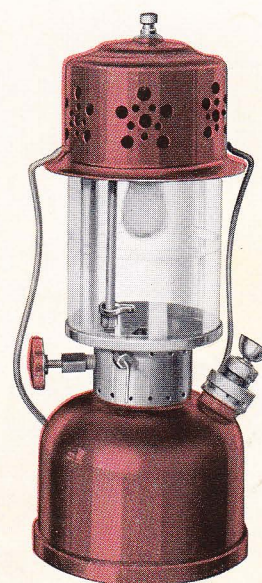

### No. 3718 Ready-Lite Lantern

Two mantle lantern with wide shade, built for heavy-duty, which will burn either gasoline or kerosene. When gasoline is used, it lights instantly, without generating. When burning kerosene, it is generated with alcohol and for this purpose an alcohol cup is located in the lower part of the generator. The base is chromium plated and the hood is maroon porcelain enamel. Has combination built-in pump and filler plug. Fount holds one quart of gasoline, sufficient for 12 to 15 hours of burning. Height,  $12\frac{1}{2}$  inches; shipping weight, 6 pounds.

### No. 3705 Ready-Lite Lantern

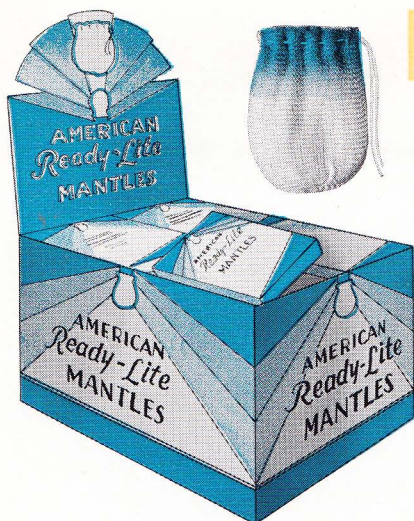
Considering its low price, this model is without a question the finest ever produced. The hood is of maroon porcelain and the fount is finished in maroon baked enamel. Globe is made of non-breakable mica. Has one mantle and is constructed so it will burn either gasoline or kerosene. Is instant lighting when gasoline is used. Has alcohol generating cup for starting the light when burning kerosene. Fount holds one pint of gasoline, sufficient for 6 to 8 hours of operation. Height, 12 inches; shipping weight, 5 pounds.

AMERICAN Ready-Lite Lanterns produce a clear, bright, white light—a light that actually compares with sunlight in its intensity. At a fuel cost of about  $\frac{1}{4}$  cent per hour, one of these lanterns will produce 300-candle power light from common, untreated gasoline or from kerosene. They are instant lighting when gasoline is used—simply open the valve and hold a lighted match to the mantle and immediately a flood of white, brilliant, pleasing light is produced. To generate the lantern when burning kerosene, an alcohol cup is provided at the base of the generator. A convenient filler is furnished with each lantern for filling this cup. A cleaning crank is conveniently located on the outside, so the orifice in the burner will always be open. A second cleaner operates automatically to keep the orifice from the fount open. AMERICAN Ready-Lite Lanterns are absolutely safe and will burn safely in any position, even upside down, and they are not affected by drafts or wind. Generators and mantles are long lasting,

simple and inexpensive to replace. Each model is equipped with a combination built-in pump and filler-plug, which not only simplifies the construction of the lantern, by making one less fitting on the base, but further guarantees that the pump can never be lost or mislaid. Finally, they are unsurpassed in the matter of appearance. Their beautiful maroon colored porcelain hoods and their distinctive modern design produce a lantern which is unsurpassed in attractiveness.



DISPLAY CARTON: Ready-Lite and Naturalite mantles are packed only six (3 pairs) in a package and one gross (24 packages) in attractive counter display cartons. They are retailed by the box and should make it unnecessary to break the package and have loose mantles or short-count packages, in stock.

COUNTER CARD: No. 7510 Ready-Lite mantles are also packed 2 in a cellophane envelope, 36 envelopes on a counter display card.

### No. 7510 Ready-Lite Mantles

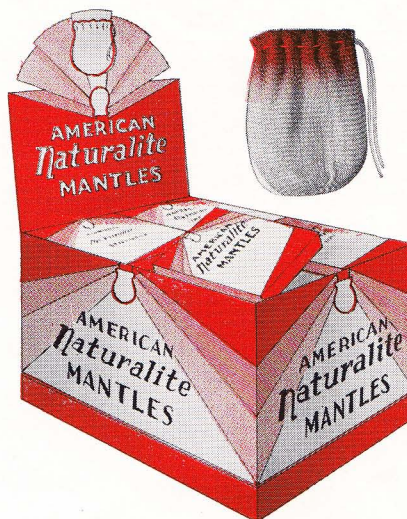

### No. 7516 Ready-Lite Mantles

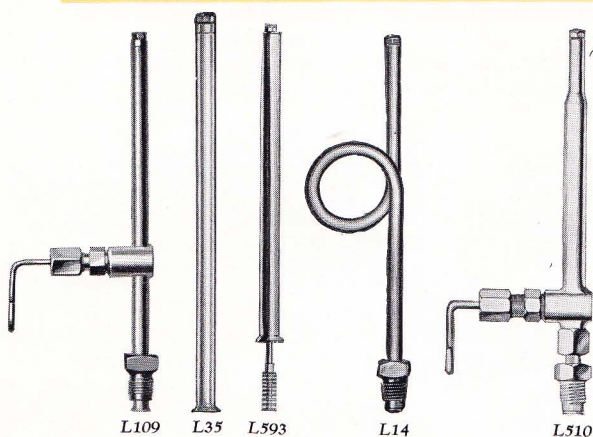

## AMERICAN READY-LITE GENERATORS



### No. L109 Ready-Lite Generator

Equipped with a cleaning needle operated by an eccentric lever. A turn of the lever cleans the gas tip at any time whether the lamp is burning or not. Fits Ready-Lite Lamps and Lanterns and other standard makes.

### No. L35 Ready-Lite Generator

This straight tube generator is inexpensive and gives excellent service. An advantage of this type is that it may be removed without the risk of breaking mantles. Fits Ready-Lite Lamps and Lanterns and other standard makes.

### No. L593 Ready-Lite Generator

A straight tube, long lasting generator. Has a cleaning needle operated by a lever attached to the valve casting. For Nos. 100, 3606, 3608, 3705 and 3708 Lanterns.

### No. L705 Ready-Lite Generator

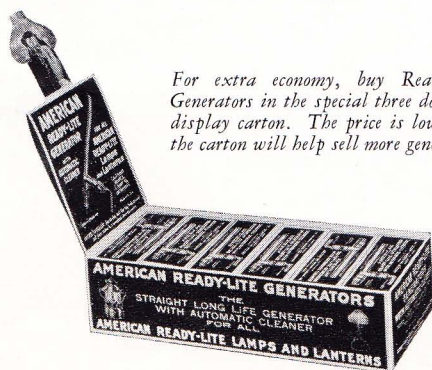
Appearance same as L593. For Nos. 101, 102, 3614, 3618 and 3718 Lanterns and Nos. 110 and 3662 Lamps.

### No. L14 Ready-Lite Generator

This coil type generator is preferred by many users. It is inexpensive, gives good service, and is very conveniently preheated with matches. Fits Ready-Lites and other standard lamps and lanterns.

### No. L510 Ready-Lite Generator

Has cleaning needle operated by an eccentric lever. At the point where carbon accumulates the tube is extra large, increasing the life of the generator. Should be used on instant lighting lamps and lanterns only.
